## 5' chicken cage Model \#545

## Installation



1. Remove the few staples that keep all the pieces together with cutting pliers.

2. Remove the staples from the front that attach the hook and the hog rings bag.

3. Remove all the pieces that are not attached to the cage.

4. Open all the sections for them to face the outside.

5. Detach the separation that has been attached differently for shipping.

6. If not already done, install a staple in the first tile of each of the partitions on the face of the cage to solidify them.

7. Install the two hooks 12" ( 30 cm ) from each side of the cage. attaches to the bottom. The higher side of the divider is the one that goes to the front of the cage.
(See picture above)

8. Staple the back of the cage (piece with 1" by 2 " squares measuring 16" by 60 " ( 40 cm by 152 cm ) with all dividers, both sides and the bottom.

9. Install the three $3 / 4$ " staples on each hook used to hold the trough.

10. Place the roof of the cage on it and staple it with all the dividers and the back.

11. Install the feeder on the third row of the front (see picture above).

12. Lift up each partition and pull them towards the back of the cage.


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6. Staple in the same way as the others the separation that has just been detached on the rod that is 12 " from the side. The side with the angled rod is the side that


11. Staple the front of the cage to all partitions and the roof. There will be a space left at the bottom to allow the eggs to roll out.
